1. Workshop for Under Graduate Architecture Students in Third Year



A "Workshop on Earthquake Resistant Practices for Undergraduate Students of Architecture" was conducted at IIT Kanpur during July 08 – 15, 2017, as a part of NICEE initiative towards reaching the architects of tomorrow through a hands-on programme in earthquake resistant architectural design. The workshop will be attended by 56 participants of 14 colleges from all over India. The aim of

this workshop was to sensitize the students of architecture in earthquake resistant design practices through technical lectures followed by design studios where they were given guidance in earthquake resistant design by working on an architectural design project.

During the eight-day workshop the students were given an architectural design assignment where they were required to design a hostel premises on a site in Jorhat, Assam, located in Seismic Zone V. Students were exposed to RESIST software to test the adequacy of their designs from seismic performance perspective and this session helped them to arrive at reasonable sizes of structural members.

Rai of IIT Kanpur apprised the participants about the *progress and hurdles of seismic risk mitigation in India*. The studio sessions were a mix of desk work and informal lectures where individual cases were used to illustrate earthquake engineering concepts to the entire class.
